Born in El Paso, Texas, COL Killian entered the Army as a Second Lieutenant in 1981 after graduating from Loyola University of Chicago.

COL Killian has been assigned to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Armored Division, Hanau, Germany, the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division (Air Assault) Fort Campbell, Kentucky the 1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas, and the 21<sup>st</sup> Theater Support Command, Kaiserslautern, Germany.

He is a graduate of the U.S. Army War College, Command and General Staff College, Combined Arms Services Staff School, the Aviation Officer Advanced Course, and the Armor Basic Officer Course. He is a command pilot and a maintenance test pilot in the UH-60 Black Hawk.

His awards include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Meritorious Service Medal with oak leaf, the Air Medal with numeral 2, and the Army Commendation Medal with four oak leaves. He also wears the Army Parachutist's Badge, Air Assault Badge and Senior Army Aviator Badge.

He has commanded D Company, 1-101<sup>st</sup> Aviation Regiment, F Company, 227<sup>th</sup> Aviation Company the 51<sup>st</sup> Maintenance Battalion and Aviation Center Logistics Command.

COL Killian is a veteran of DESERT SHIELD/DESERT STORM, Kosovo, Bosnia and most recently OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM where he served as the Special Operations Command-Europe Logistics Officer (J-4).
