COL Timothy L. Faulkner is the Deputy Director of Installation Management Command Pacific Region. He is from Newport News, Virginia. While attending the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, he served in the 30th Infantry Brigade North Carolina National Guard and was a member of the Armed Forces Military Pentathlon Team. Upon graduation in 1989, he was commissioned as a Field Artillery Officer. While in Field Artillery, he served as a Platoon Leader, Fire Direction Officer, Executive Officer, and Fire Support Officer in the 1-39th FAR (ABN) FT Bragg, NC. He deployed with the 82nd Airborne Division in support of Operations DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM.

In 1993, COL Faulkner was branch detailed to Military Intelligence and served as an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Operations Officer, Company C Commander and Battalion S3 Operations Officer, 305th Military Intelligence Battalion, 111th MI Brigade, Fort Huachuca, AZ. After attending the Military Intelligence Officer Advance Course, COL Faulkner served as the Detachment Commander Electronic Warfare Group, Italy from 1996-1997 where he deployed with II Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF) and AFSOUTH in Operations JOINT ENDEAVOR and JOINT GUARD.

His next assignment was as the Chief of Intelligence, Brigade S2, 2nd Brigade, 1st Armor Division, Baumholder, Germany. In 1998, he deployed to support Operation JOINT FORGE in Bosnia-Herzegovina. Shortly after his return, COL Faulkner deployed with 2nd Brigade to Tirana, Albania in support of Operation ALLIED FORCE in Kosovo. After leaving 1st Armor Division in 1999, he attended the Command and General Staff College at FT Leavenworth, Kansas.

In 2000, he served as the G2 Intelligence Operations Officer 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, TX. In 2001, COL Faulkner served as the Executive Officer for the 303rd Military Intelligence Battalion. He later served as the Chief Intel Planner in the III Corps G3 War Plans section. In August 2002, COL Faulkner became the Brigade S3 Operations Officer for the 504th Military Intelligence Brigade during Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM. From 2003-2005, he served for the Director of National Security Agency as the Chief of Planning and Requirements at the National Security Agency FT Meade, MD. In June 2005, he assumed command of the 501st Military Intelligence Battalion, 1st Armored Division, McCully Barracks, Germany where the unit deployed for Operation IRAQI FREEDOM to support the Multi-National Corps Iraq, Joint Special Operations Task Force Iraq and Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. His next assignment was the Deputy G2, Assistant Chief of Staff V Corps. In 2007, COL Faulkner was selected for promotion and attendance at the United States Army War College, Carlisle Barracks, PA.

COL Faulkner served as the commander United States Army Garrison Fort Huachuca, AZ from 2009 to 2012.

COL Faulkner's military education includes: Basic Field Artillery Course; Airborne and Ranger School; Military Intelligence Advance Course; Signal Intelligence Course; Human Intelligence Course; Combined Arms and Services Staff School; Command and General Staff College; Joint Forces Staff College and the US Army War College.

COL Faulkner holds a Bachelor of Arts from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Masters of Science in Administration from Central Michigan University and a Masters in Strategic Studies from the US Army War College.
